- 3) Assignment Instructions: Here you will input any specific instructions for students about completing this work. After selecting the 'Assign' button, students will be able to fully access this material from their student accounts.

You can see all lessons you've assigned, and to who, on the Assignments tab on your User Dashboard at any time.

Once you've sent your students their assignments, you can view the status of the assignment for each student. You can also see their quiz results, including the number of quiz attempts, first score and best score.

Customizing Your Lectures

When you lecture in class, every student hears the same thing. When you flip your classroom with Study.com, you can vary your assignments in order to customize them to specific student needs. Assign extra videos to students who need additional remediation or are ready for more difficult topics. Reassign videos to a student you think needs a review.
